Active listening is a key skill in effective communication, and crucial to facilitating effective dialogue Three common listening modes, relevant to dialogue situations: 1 Competitive or combative listening happens when we are more interested in promoting our own point of view than in understanding or exploring someone else's view

**Active listening - RiPFA**

Active listening involves taking a step back, not jumping to conclusions or making assumptions It requires patience and resisting the temptation to take control of what is going on and/or come up with solutions for the person - it can be a difficult skill to master and takes practice to perfect

active listening is based on attitude, stemming from the listener's perspective or conviction Secondly, active listening is the use of certain technical skills
